Why Church Membership?

Corporate Confession

Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.

Hebrews 13:17

Consider these biblical truths:

- The Church is God's Work
- God's Vision for the Church is Glorious
- Membership in the Church is a biblical idea
- Church Membership is an implicit requirement of the Christian life

Church membership is for our **encouragement**, our **protection** and our **instruction**.

When you commit to Church membership, you are called to a higher degree of responsibility, service, and sacrifice to one another.

Pastor: Heavenly Father, Ephesians 6:11 commands us to, "put on the full armor of God," which is nothing less than putting on all of Christ, so that we may stand firm against the wiles of the devil.

Congregation: Yet we confess that often we have treated our faith as less than all of Christ.

Pastor: Lord you teach us that our enemy, the devil, roams around like a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour. And you have promised that you will not allow us to be tempted beyond our ability and that you will provide a way for us to escape so that we can endure.

Congregation: Lord we confess that we have missed the mark, given into temptation, and have profaned the name of Christ.

Pastor: Merciful Lord, we come this morning acknowledging that although we are your children, often we give into the temptations of the flesh. Father give us a contrite spirit this morning that desires to be conformed into the image of Christ. Hear us now as we confess our sins.
